# **Critical Items at Enger**

- 1. Install new irrigation central control.
- 2 Excavate new irrigation pond w/ lining and grading of spoils.
- ▶ 3. Upgrade irrigation pump station w/ fill line, power & pump house.
- 4. Install new irrigation system (27-holes)
- ▶ 5. Improve fairway drainage and re-grass Back Nine.
- 6. Improve fairway drainage and re-grass Middle Nine.
- > 7. Renovate 11 fairway and greenside bunkers on Back Nine.
- 8. Renovate/remove 8 bunkers on Front and Middle Nine.
- 9. Construct new forward tees to improve playability.
- 10. Remodel clubhouse (bathrooms, food service, plumbing, etc.)

# Critical Items at Enger

- 1. Replace irrigation pump station w/ fill line, power & pump house.
- 2. Install new irrigation system pipe and sprinklers (27-holes).
- 3. Regrade and regrass fairways on front nine holes 2 and 9.
- ▶ 4. Regrade and regrass fairways on middle nine, hole nine.
- ▶ 5. Regrade and regrass fairways on back nine holes 1, 2, 5-9.
- 6. Renovate 13 bunkers and remove 13 bunkers.
- 7. Construct 9 new forward tees.
- 8. Construct new modular clubhouse, including demolition of existing.

  - ► Food and beverage
  - Outdoor dining and entertainment area with limited indoor area
  - Restrooms
  - Storage
- > 1) Prefabricated modular structure
- 2) Conversion of the existing pavilion/garage building
