Northeast Regional Correction Center (NERCC) escapee Eugene Raymond Hawpetoss was arrested in Duluth last night.

On Wednesday, October 28, 2009, at 9:33 PM, Duluth Police received information that NERCC escapee Eugene Raymond Hawpetoss was currently at an apartment in the 300 Block of South 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue East. Police, along with St. Louis County Sheriff Deputies, went to the address and within a short time Hawpetoss was taken into custody without incident. Hawpetoss was transported to the St. Louis County Jail where he was lodged for Escape from Custody.

Hawpetoss escaped Monday when he was being transferred from NERCC to the St. Louis County Jail.
