Two charged in apartment burglary.

On Monday, October 25, 2010 at 2:35 PM, Duluth Police responded to the 300 Block of North Fourth Avenue West on the report that an apartment burglary had just occurred. The caller said that they had seen a male and female enter the apartment building, heard what sounded like a door being forced open, and then saw the two leave carrying a flat screen TV. The caller then found the neighbor's apartment door kicked in and called 9-1-1. The two suspects were last seen walking east on Fourth Street.

A description of the two suspects was given and officers located them nearby. The two were identified as Christopher Forest Cook, age 34 of Duluth, and Dawnis Marie Bosto, age 28 of Cloquet. Both were taken into custody without incident. The flat screen TV was later located at a nearby address.

Cook and Bosto were taken to the St. Louis County Jail where they were held. Both appeared this morning in Sixth Judicial District Court in Duluth and were charged with Second Degree Burglary and Fourth Degree Criminal Damage to Property. Their bail was set at \$8000.00 each.

The Duluth Police Department would like to recognize the importance of alert citizens that have called in suspicious individuals over the last three days. With the information these citizens were able to provide police; two suspects have been arrested for prowling vehicles and two others for burglary.
