Kimberly Sannes brought the City Standard Construction Specifications book and the MNDOT specification book and explained how contractors are made aware of the standards for each project. She noted that the Engineering Dept. does, indeed, issue permits, such as those for excavation of city property.

She brought up the idea of having a city-wide boulevard tree project. Homeowners who wanted to have boulevard trees planted could be assessed (like if they asked for sidewalk) for trees. Discussion included questions about money for maintenance, staffing, and so on.
