

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Resolution 13-0422R awarded a contract to Limnotech for professional engineering design services on streams on the western side of Duluth, including Mission, Kingsbury, Sargent, Keene and Merritt Creeks. Additional grant funding was awarded to the city in February 2014 by the Board of Water and Soil Resources. Two sites on Kingsbury and Keene Creeks adjacent to existing Limnotech projects can be added to the contract in order to expedite the projects. This resolution authorizes an increase to the contract in the amount of \$58,819 for a new total of \$265,819, payable from Disaster Recovery Fund 225, Department 126 (Finance), Division 1807 (Parks, Recreation and Other), Object 5303 (Engineering Services), city project no. 1186.
