Word on the Street Weekly Update (August 20-24, 2018)

Wrap-up of This Week

-Hot water pipes installation was finished in the 4th Avenue W. intersection and toward 3rd Avenue W. on Superior Street.

-Crews worked to back fill between 3th Avenue W. and 5th Avenue W. to prepare for concrete work in the coming weeks.

-The watermain was installed across 6th Avenue W.

-The sidewalks in front of maurices have been backfilled and graded to prepare for concrete next week.

-The signal base was poured on the southwest corner of 4th Avenue W.

What to Expect August 27- September 1

-Access to businesses and residences remain open.

-Please note, sidewalk routes will be changing in the coming weeks to accommodate and prepare for concrete pours in sidewalk sections. Business doors will remain accessible. Take care to look for changes to kiosks and signage for pedestrian reroutes. Each block will have one side that remains open fully open to pedestrian traffic.

-Sidewalk concrete will be poured in front of maurices.

-Crews are installing hot water between the tunnel and 6th Avenue W.

-Utility work will continue along 4th Avenue W. The alleys will remain accessible from 5th Ave West and 3rd Avenue West, but through traffic onto 4th Avenue W. is not allowed.

-Hot water connections to buildings will continue.

Mesaba Ave to I35 Project (MNDOT)

-The Mesaba Avenue reconstruction/bridge project in Duluth will require the closure of the parts of the intersection at Central Entrance/Mesaba Avenue/6th Avenue and Rice Lake Road again this coming weekend. The partial closure will occur from 7 p.m., Friday, August 24 through 5 a.m., Monday, August 27. Limited movements will be allowed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes or use the <u>posted detour route</u>. The ramp from southbound I-35 to eastbound Highway 2 remains closed until Thursday, August 30. This closure is necessary to allow crews to paint the portion of the ramp that is over water. To expedite progress, the contractor is working seven days per week during this closure. The signed detour will be south on I-35 to Central Avenue, back north on I-35 and right on the ramp to eastbound Highway 2. For more information visit
