Wrap-up of This Week

-Waterproofing and sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.

-Parking lanes were installed between 3rd Avenue W and 5th Avenue W.

-The eastbound driving lane between 4th Avenue W and 5th Avenue W was installed.

-The landscape wall installation to the east of the Gateway building was completed.

-Hot water service installation is complete in the roadway. Interior work and testing are continuing on site.

-Crews worked to build the road up to grade in preparation of concrete pouring.

What to Expect September 30 – October 6

-Access to businesses and residences remain open.

-Please note, sidewalk routes will be changing in the coming weeks to accommodate for preparing for concrete pours in

sidewalks. Business doors will remain accessible. Take care to look for changes to kiosks and additional signage for

pedestrian reroutes. Each block will have one side that remains open fully open to pedestrian traffic.

-Flatwork crews will be pouring concrete in phases, ensuring proper drying time prior to driving on site.

-Curb and gutter will be installed west of 6th Avenue W.

-Roadway portions will be installed between 3rd Avenue W and 5th Avenue W.

-Road grade will continue along the project to prepare for concrete.
