**Word on the Street Weekly Update (October 1-5, 2018)**

**Wrap-up of This Week**

- Waterproofing and sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.
- The westbound driving lane between 3rd Avenue W and 5th Avenue W was installed as well as the roadway heading on 4th Avenue W.
- Curb and gutter between 5th Avenue W. and 7th Avenue W was installed.
- The last critical connection for steam was made in the 6th Avenue W intersection.
- Crews brought the road to grade in preparation of additional concrete installation.

**What to Expect October 7 - 13**

- Access to businesses and residences remain open.
- Please note, sidewalk routes will be changing in the coming weeks to accommodate preparation for sidewalk concrete pours. Business doors will remain accessible. Take care to look for changes to kiosks and additional signage for pedestrian reroutes. Each block will have one side that remains fully open to pedestrian traffic.
- Flatwork crews will be pouring concrete in phases, ensuring proper drying time. Weather is a factor with concrete but crews are working hard to take advantage of any decent weather.
- Portions of sidewalk will continue to be installed over the next two weeks around business hours.
- Crews will be installing wiring through the electrical ducts as well as light poles.


## Love Downtown Duluth
