Wrap-up of This Week

- -Sidewalk work is finished for the season.
- -Electrical crews continued installing street lights and steel for traffic signals.
- -Bus stops and amenities were installed between 5th Avenue W. and 7th Avenue W.
- -Crews worked on buttoning up details between 3rd Avenue W. and 5th Avenue W.

What to Expect November 11-17

- -The Superior Street project partners are working to coordinate the road opening between 5th Avenue W. to 7th Avenue W. with MnDOT's Mesabi Avenue project for an opening by the end of the week.
- -6th Avenue W. will be open to traffic.
- -Access to businesses and residences remain open.
- -Front door access to the Duluth Library was restored.
- -Crews will continue to stripe the roadway.
- -The railing near the Gateway building will be installed in the coming weeks.
- -Detailed work items will continue along the project.
