Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (June 12, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- Storm sewer structures were installed on 1st Avenue East
- Electrical ducts between Lake Avenue – 1st Avenue East were installed.
- Asbestos removal from the steam pipes is complete between Lake Avenue – 3rd Avenue East. Additional removal will begin again in July.
- Large steam vaults were set in place.
- Trees were planted from 3rd Avenue West – 7th Avenue West

What to Expect June 12th – 18th

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Pipefitters are prefabricating the hot water and steam lines off site.
- Crews are working to install signal bases on at the 1st Avenue East intersection.
- More electrical duct work will be placed.
- Landscaping work continues near the Gateway Tower on 6th Avenue West
- Crews will install more benches and begin work on installing the granite benches in the bump outs at 4th Avenue West

- All are welcome at the weekly construction update meeting every Tuesday at 9:00 am at Greysolon on the ballroom level.

Clean and Safe Team
