Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (August 6, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- Concrete crews finished pouring concrete on 1st Avenue.
- Crews installed more storm drainage systems and electrical ducts within 4th Avenue East.
- Prep work was done to install more steam and hot water lines.
- Grading begin between Lake Avenue and 1st Avenue East.

Traffic Changes Expected on Thursday, August 8

- This Thursday, August 8, 1st Avenue East will open and 3rd Avenue East will close to vehicle traffic. Traffic on Michigan St from 1st Avenue East to 4th Avenue East will convert to two way for the remainder of the Superior Street construction project.

What to Expect July August 7-13

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Crews will finish the 1st Avenue East intersection for opening on Thursday, August 8.
- 3rd Avenue East will close and the surface roadway will be removed to prepare for work in the intersection.
- Pipefitters continue to install the steam and hot water lines between 2nd Avenue East and Lake Avenue.
- Storm structures work will continue at 4th Avenue East.
- Light and signal bases are being installed throughout the project.

- All are welcome at the weekly construction update meeting every Tuesday at 9:00 a.m. at Greysolon on the ballroom level.

Clean and Safe Team

- The Clean and Safe Team (in bright yellow shirts) are helpful construction navigators. Look for them in the construction zone.
