Duluth Recognized for Achievement of Excellence in Financial Reporting

[Duluth, MN] - The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting was awarded to the City of Duluth Auditor's Office by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management.

An Award of Financial Reporting Achievement is typically awarded to the individual department designated by the government as primarily responsible for preparing the awarding winning CAFR. The City of Duluth's Auditor's Office provided the following statement about this award and recognition.
