## **Duluth Parks & Recreation 2024 Summer Day Camps Guide**

Day Camp Registration opens on Tuesday March 5 at 8:00 a.m. online at <u>duluthmn.gov/parks/register</u>. Registering from a desktop works more efficiently than from a phone in our online system. You can Create an Account in advance to save time during registration:

#### **Create an Account:**

- Go to duluthmn.gov/parks/register
- Select "Create an Account"
- Enter all required information (all relevant family members, contact information, and birthdates must be entered make sure the year is correct)

## **Cancelation Policy – Summer Day Camps**

Participants wishing to withdraw from a summer day camp program must do so at least 30 days prior to the start of the program to qualify for a full refund (or account credit) minus a \$5 non-refundable admin fee per person per camp.

- o 30 days or less: refunds can be issued only if your spot can be filled from our Waitlist minus the \$5 non-refundable admin fee per person per camp.
- Partial refunds after the start of the program are only considered if injury or serious illness occurs and must be approved.
- o Refunds can take up to three weeks to process.
- o If a program is canceled by Parks and Recreation, full refunds will be issued.

#### Fee Assistance

Financial assistance is available for families that qualify; information and application can be found under the Programs & Events tab at <u>duluthmn.gov/parks</u>. Please complete the form and return the Parks Office (email to <u>parks@duluthmn.gov</u> or to Sam at email below; paper copies can be mailed to or dropped off at City Hall, ATTN: Parks & Recreation).

Note: Completing this form in advance can save time during registration; returning your form does not provide immediate access to fee assistance funds – approval and account input by staff creates your ability to register for programs using assistance balance.

Once approved, staff will contact you and your CivicRec account will show a Scholarship balance per person to use towards qualifying programs.
