1. Call to Order: 5:37pm
2. Roll Call: Board members(Chair Vaccarella, Vice Chair Dani Dunphy, member Beyer, Member Franklin) Chief Ceynowa , Deputy Chief Morris, Lieutenant Ring, Councilor Swenson, Human Rights Officer Carl Crawford

4. Board Introductions to City Councilor Swenson who was in attendance
5. Minutes were approved and on the record that there has been a lack of minutes being completed for some time even after public comments that there has been no minutes to post.
6. Police Liaison Report
 - Talked about the report of complaints and compliments with public request that the key be posted with the list so that it can be deciphered by the public. They have been working on the spread sheet for the complaints and compliments to make them more user friendly and have enough information that people can tell what is really happening. Also talked about having someone from the parking division come and talk with us about the complaints and rules around parking that have had significant impact on certain neighborhoods in town.

 - Reports on the first drone usage and it seemed to have gone well from the point of view of the department. The fall hiring was completed and 2 new officers where hired and will start training with the department in February. There will be another hiring drive in April when recruits are coming out of law enforcement education programs and looking for employment with agencies. The department is still down about 16 officers.

 - The president is coming to town and DPD will have a significance presence to secure safety for that visit.
