Due to the High Risk of Rip Currents today, the Duluth Fire Department is issuing a **warning for danger** effective immediately and continuing until 10:00 a.m. tomorrow. This warning means that wind and wave conditions are threatening to anyone entering the water. Stay out of the water regardless of your swimming experience.

There are currently no lifeguards at Park Point, and red flags are flying along the beach to indicate the danger.

Flag locations are: 12th St beach, Lafayette Square, and Park Point beach. You will be notified if swimming conditions change.
