All volunteer days will be staffed and supervised by a City of Duluth Park Maintenance employee.

The 'Pick a Day' schedule is as follows:

- Mondays Lakewalk Meet at the Vietnam Memorial at 10:00 AM Mulching flowers and shrub beds, weeding flower gardens, picking up trash and painting benches.
- Tuesdays Rose Garden Meet at the Rose Garden Gazebo at 10:00 AM Deadheading roses, weeding flower beds, watering annuals, mulching and picking up trash.
- Wednesdays Trail Projects You can call 218-269-4712 for specific trail projects and locations. Trail resurfacing, bridge repair, trail realignment, signing and trash pick up.
- Thursdays Enger Park Meet in the parking lot at 10:00 AM Deadheading and weeding flower beds, watering annuals, mulching and picking up trash.
- Fridays Park Point Beach Meet the beach house on the lake side at 10:00 AM Sweeping the beach for trash and debris that has washed ashore.
- Saturdays Special Projects You can call 218-730-4312 for specific project information/location This is designed for large groups of people who want to concentrate their efforts on a specific one day project.
