The City of Duluth, Minnesota requests sealed bids for the above named project. **Due to the closure of City Hall due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all bids must be submitted electronically through Bid Express® at <u>www.bidexpress.com</u>. The City Purchasing Agent or her designee will conduct a public bid opening immediately after the deadline for receiving bids. Bidders may view the opening by going to the Purchasing web page (<u>https://www.duluthmn.gov/bids-request-for-proposals/</u>) and selecting the appropriate link.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION & MAJOR WORK ITEMS: The project includes the construction of a sanitary sewer extension along the existing utility easement between Denim Drive and Lot 4, Block 2 of the Western Woods Division, as well as along the property within Western Woods Division. Construction includes the installation of new sanitary sewer pipe, structures, services, and site restoration.

Plans and specifications are on file for inspection at the Minnesota Builder's Exchange, BXWI-Fox Valley Plan Room, and Blue Book Building and Construction Network.

Bidders must review the 2019 edition of the City of Duluth Public Works/Utilities Department – Engineering Division Standard Construction Specifications (available at https://www.duluthmn.gov/engineering/standard-construction-specifications/) as these Specifications are incorporated by reference.

Bid surety in an amount equal to five per cent (5%) of the total bid shall be submitted with each bid. Electronic bid surety can be submitted in Bid Express. For the duration of the City Hall closure to the public as a result of COVID-19, bid bonds may also be emailed to <u>purchasing@duluthmn.gov</u>. The emailed bid bond must be received by purchasing office prior to the bid opening, and must be verifiable with the surety company. Any exceptions to submitting bid bonds other than via Bid Express or email must be arranged in advance with the Purchasing office.

Not less than prevailing wages as included in the specifications and provisions must be paid on this project. A Project Labor Agreement (PLA) and Community Benefits provisions will be required for any bid that is over or could virtually go over \$150,000.

The contractor must take affirmative action to ensure that the employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, creed, sex or national origin, and must meet the affirmative action goals. Contractors are encouraged to subcontract with Disadvantaged Business Enterprises when possible. Contractor will comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations.

The City of Duluth reserves the right to waive informalities and to reject any or all bids.
