Notice is hereby given that Online Bids will be received by the City of Duluth, on behalf of the Duluth Airport Authority, until 2:00pm, Monday, June 14, 2021. Bids must be submitted electronically through Bid Express® at [www.bidexpress.com](http://www.bidexpress.com), for the furnishing of all labor and material for the construction of 2021 Hangar Area Pavement Rehabilitation. The City Purchasing Agent will conduct a public bid opening via webex, immediately after the deadline for receiving bids. Major components of the Work include: 11,000 SY bituminous pavement milling, 2,500 tons bituminous pavement (State Spec.), aggregate base, pavement marking.

A Contractor responding to these Bidding Documents must submit to the City/Owner a signed statement under oath by an owner or officer verifying compliance with each of the minimum criteria in Minnesota Statutes, section 16C.285, subdivision 3.

This Work shall be subject to minimum wages and labor standards in accordance with City of Duluth, US Department of Labor and the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry.
