The City Purchasing Agent will conduct a virtual public bid opening immediately after the deadline for receiving bids. This purchase is funded through the American Rescue Plan Act. Federal terms and conditions shall apply.

Pricing shall be FOB destination with delivery to the City of Duluth Public Works and Utilities Garfield Warehouse, 520 Garfield Ave., Duluth, MN 55802. No added freight or handling charges will be allowed.

The City of Duluth is tax exempt; do not include tax in the bid price. A copy of the exemption form will be provided upon request.
