Notice is hereby given that Online Bids will be received by the City of Duluth, on behalf of the Duluth Airport authority, until 2:00pm, Friday, May 12, 2023. Bids may be submitted electronically through Bid Express® at www.bidexpress.com, for the furnishing of all labor and material for the 2023 Taxiway C North Rehabilitation. The City Purchasing Agent will conduct a public bid opening via webex livestream, immediately after the deadline for receiving bids. Major components of the Work include: cold milling asphalt pavement; HMA paving; pavement marking

This Work shall be subject to minimum wages and labor standards in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 177.41 through 177.44 (prevailing wage rates).
