Notice is hereby given that Online Bids will be received by the City of Duluth, on behalf of the Duluth Airport Authority, until 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 11, 2023. Bids may be submitted electronically through Bid Express® at www.bidexpress.com, for the furnishing of all labor and material for the construction of Taxiway A Reconstruction Phase 3. The City Purchasing Agent will conduct a public bid opening via webex livestream, immediately after the deadline for receiving bids. Major components of the Work include:

Taxiway A Reconstruction Phase 3:

16,000 SY 13-inch P-501 PCC, 14,000 tons bituminous pavement (State Spec., P-401 and P-403 mixes), 70,000 CY excavation, 10,000 CY P-209 crushed aggregate base, 25,000 CY P-154 granular borrow, pavement marking, turf restoration, lighting and conduit, 6,000 LF storm drain pipe with inlets, and 7,000 LF drain tile.

A Contractor responding to these Bidding Documents must submit to the City/Owner a signed statement under oath by an owner or officer verifying compliance with each of the minimum criteria in Minnesota Statutes, section 16C.285, subdivision 3.

This Work shall be subject to minimum wages and labor standards in accordance with City of Duluth, US Department of Labor and the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry.

The City of Duluth reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein and to award the Contract in the best interests of the City of Duluth and the Duluth Airport Authority.
