INVITATION TO BID

DISREGARD the following paragraph from the Invitation to Bid:

“The City of Duluth will use a combination of funding (ARRA funds and non-ARRA funds) to finance this project. Both federal Davis Bacon prevailing wages and State of Minnesota prevailing wages apply to this project. Payment of the wage and fringe benefits that are most beneficial to the employees are required.”

do allow payment of overtime after forty hours per week

WAGE RATES:

When both State of Minnesota and Federal Government (general decision) wage rates are included in a contract, the higher of the two rates for any classification must be paid.

State of Minnesota prevailing wages typically list two rates for each classification with two effective dates. Should any City of Duluth contract continue to and past the second effective date, that rate and fringe benefit will be in effect through the remainder of the project.
