**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The City of Duluth Police Department is requesting quotes for the purchase of six (6) each K8A 17F and one (1) ea K8A 17F U Ford Utility Police Interceptors.

**QUESTIONS:** Please submit any questions regarding this project via e-mail to <u>purchasing@duluthmn.gov</u>. Responses will be provided to all interested bidders as an addendum to this solicitation.

The selected contractor will be issued a purchase order once City Council grants approval.

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

All bids must be complete, signed, and transmitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the bid number, subject matter, and opening date.

Bids may be mailed to the Purchasing Office, City Hall, 411 West 1st Street, Room 100, Duluth, MN 55802 or dropped off in person at the same address.

Bids must be received in Purchasing before 2:00 PM local time on the bid opening date specified in the Invitation for Bids. The City Purchasing Agent or her designee will conduct a public bid opening in Room 100 immediately following receipt of the bids. Once all bids have been reviewed, bid results will be posted online at http://www.duluthmn.gov/purchasing/bids-request-for-proposals/.

No alternatives to the specification will be considered unless specifically requested. Erasures or other changes to the bid must be initialed and dated, however no special conditions shall be made or included in the bid form by the bidder.

The City of Duluth reserves the right to split the award where there is a substantial savings to the City, to waive informalities and to reject any and all bids. Do not include sales tax in the unit price, unless specifically requested. Price may not be the only consideration for bid award. Bids must be firm for a minimum of 30 days.

#### The following document must be submitted with your bid:

1. **Acknowledgment of Addendum** – any changes to this solicitation will be announced via Addendum. Bidders must indicate that they have reviewed any addendum(s) by initialing and dating on the bid form where indicated. Failure to acknowledge addendum(s) may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Please note that the following requirements also apply to this project, and any additional required documents must be submitted prior to award/contract execution. Submitting these documents with your bid will assist in expediting the process.

1. **Affidavit of Non-Collusion** – The successful bidder shall be required to execute the attached affidavit stating that he/she has not entered into a collusive agreement with any other person, firm, or corporation in regard to any bid submitted.

#### SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All vehicles must include Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) equipment unless otherwise allowed. Any options must be OEM unless otherwise called for. All equipment must meet all state and federal regulations.

**Price:** Vehicle Price consists of all dealer costs associated with delivering a completed vehicle as ordered that includes, but is not limited to the following expenses:

- dealer profit and overhead,
- dealer prep costs, ordering processing costs, manufacturer's statement of origin, pre-delivery and service "make-ready" requirements,
- one additional OEM programmed key set (chipped key, key, fob, and/or cut key identical to that provided by the OEM with the vehicle as offered), and
- at least one quarter tank of fuel.

Fees associated with licensing, registration, and the titling of the motor vehicle are NOT included in the vehicle price; these items must be listed as separate line items on the invoice and quote. All costs shall be billed at the current rates published by the Minnesota Department of Public Safety. The successful bidder will process the required paperwork for licensing, registration, and title transfer.

Prices are to be FOB destination, freight prepaid and allowed.

**Taxes:** No taxes should be calculated into the cost of the vehicle. Taxes will be calculated and invoiced, if applicable, as a separate line item on the invoice.

**State Excise Tax:** A 6.5% Motor Vehicle Sales Tax is imposed on the sale of motor vehicles per MN State Sec. 297B.02. The successful bidder is responsible for collecting the excise tax, and making payment to the Department of Public Safety's motor vehicle registrar on behalf of the City.

As a point of clarification, the following taxes DO NOT apply to the sale of motor vehicles:

- General Sales and Use Tax
- City and County Local Tax
- Federal Excise Tax (the City is Exempt)
- Transit Improvement 0.25% Sales and Use Tax

**Equipment Warranty:** The manufacturer's standard warranty service shall be applicable. No dealer or vendor warranty programs will be accepted. A copy of the warranty should be included at the time the quote is submitted. Warranty time periods will commence when the vehicle is delivered to the ship to address listed on the purchase order. Drop shipments constitute a delivery.

**Order Processing:** Any final quotations provided to the purchaser, if requested, must include a dealer's print-out for each model requested, showing how the vehicle is equipped. If there is any inaccurate information in the print-out, the successful bidder may make corrections in ink and must initial that correction prior to submitting it with the quotation.

Quotations shall not contain terms which require the City to pay for the purchase prior to 30 days after receipt of the invoice or 30 days after the City's acceptance of the merchandise, whichever is later.

Successful bidder shall provide written confirmation to the purchaser within 72 hours after receipt of order and must include the estimated delivery date of the vehicles.

**Confirmation in Writing:** New orders or change orders must be confirmed in writing by the City. Verbal orders may not be processed by the successful bidder.

**Delivery:** Successful bidder must contact the City prior to delivery of any order to confirm the date and time the vehicles will be delivered. Payment terms shall be net 30 and do not begin until the vehicle is inspected and accepted by the City or if the vehicle is held by the successful bidder, the day the vehicle is accepted by the City.

If the successful bidder fails to meet the required delivery date agreed to by the City and the successful bidder, the City reserves the right to cancel the purchase order without any penalty charges from the

successful bidder and may consider the successful bidder in default.

**Pre-Delivery and Service:** Prior to the delivery, vehicles must be completely serviced by the successful bidder or must be certified by the successful bidder that it has been performed, in accordance with the manufacturer's standard "make-ready" recommendations. The vehicle must contain at least one-quarter tank of fuel when delivered. Each vehicle must contain a pre-delivery check sheet showing which operations have been performed on the vehicle by the successful bidder.

Any work found incomplete, not covered by warranty, will be done in the field and the cost billed back to the successful bidder. The shop rate will be determined by the City.

Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO) must be delivered with the vehicle. The agency shown must match the bill-to address on the purchase order for licensing and recall notices. A copy of the confirming order, initialed by the successful bidder and the City, must also be delivered with the vehicle.

**Name Plates**: Dealer nameplates, decals, etc., denoting the selling dealer <u>may not</u> be affixed in any manner to any new model vehicle delivered.

**Inspection.** The successful bidder must notify the City at least 72 hours before delivery to allow the purchaser to inspect the vehicle. This inspection will be made to check workmanship, specifications and compliance with manufacturer's make-ready procedures and will not preclude or replace final inspection and approval of the using agency. A copy of the factory make-up sheet and a copy of the make-ready service check list, signed by the successful bidder service manager, must be available for review when vehicles are ready for inspection. This service list must accompany the delivery slip when the unit is delivered.

**Final Acceptance:** All equipment furnished will be subject to inspection and acceptance by the City after delivery. No substitutions are permitted without prior written approval of the City. If requested by the City after final inspection, and if mutually agreed, the successful bidder will hold the new vehicles for the City up to 30 days to allow the purchaser to move the vehicles to subcontractors for storage. The time the vehicles are held by the successful bidder will not negate final acceptance nor payment to the successful bidder.

**Vehicle Licensing.** The successful bidder is responsible for licensing, registration, and transfer of title to the City. All applicable document costs shall be billed at the current rates published by the Minnesota Department of Public Safety. The cost to process the paperwork must be mutually agreed to by the City and the successful bidder. The mutually agreed cost MUST be detailed as a separate line item on the purchase order and the invoice.

Vehicle Registration with the Manufacturer. In order to manage any manufacturer's recall notices that may be issued, the successful bidder will be responsible for providing the manufacturer with the City's name and address – by vehicle identification number (VIN) or fleet identification number (FIN). If the City is required to secure its FIN number from the manufacturer, the successful bidder will provide all of the necessary information and will ensure that the final required information has been submitted to the manufacturer.

The City of Duluth is an Equal Opportunity Employer. Contractor shall comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations.
