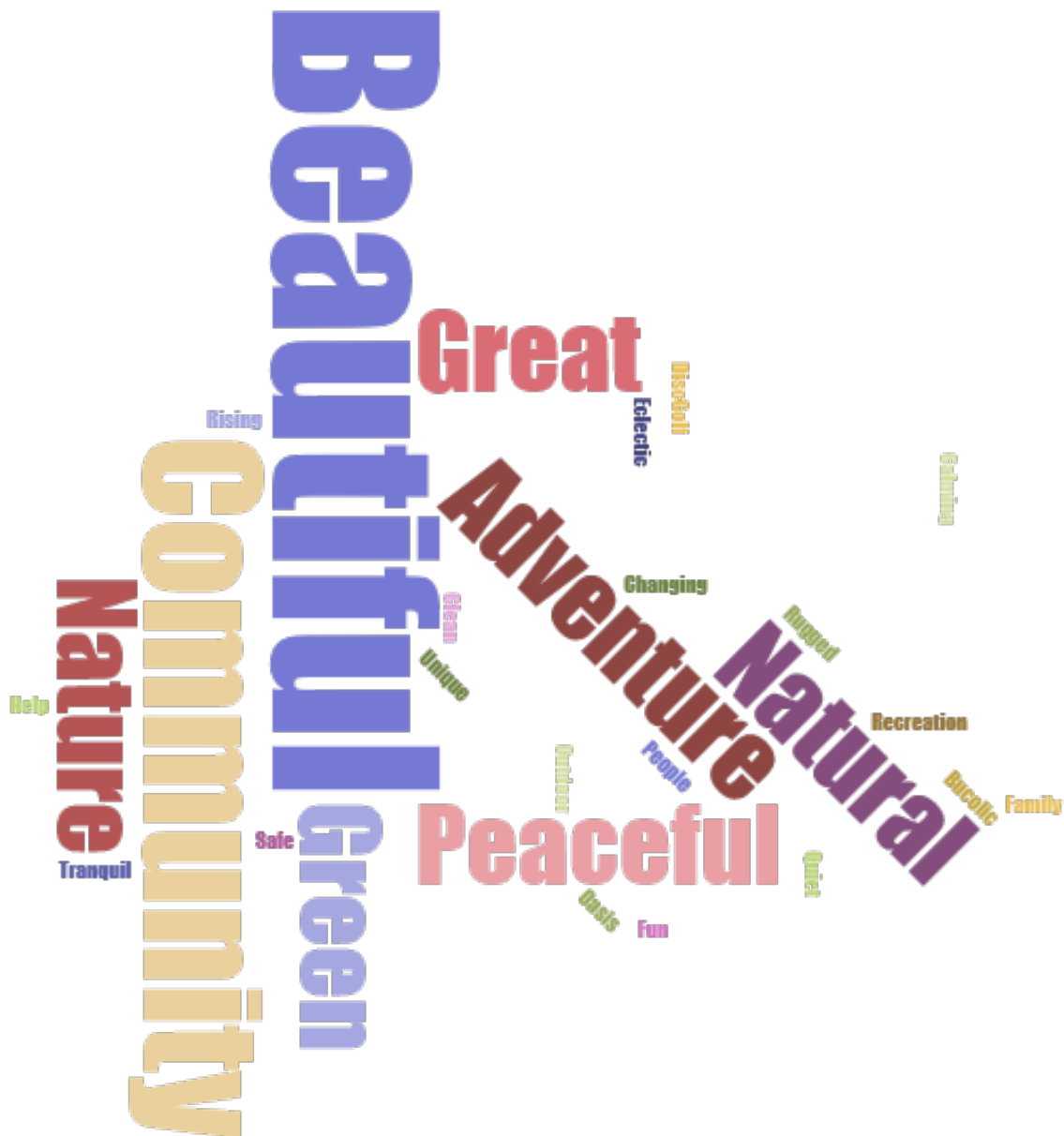


# Engagement Outcomes

What Word Best Describes Lincoln Park?



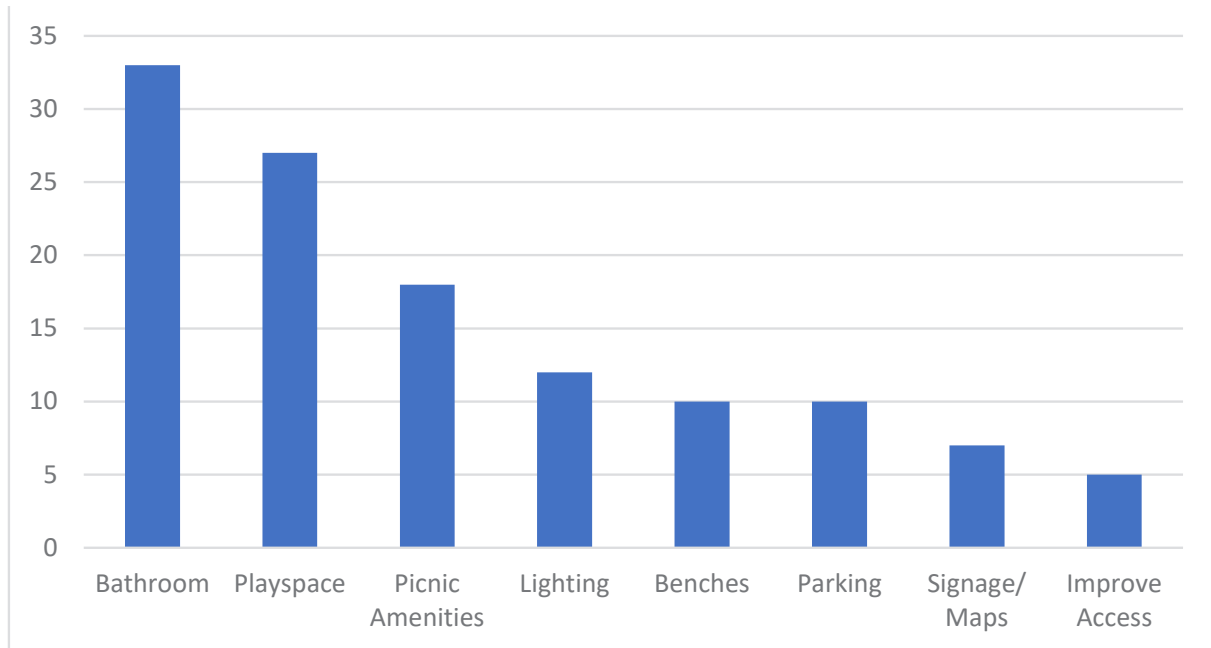
Responses from 54 surveys. Words appearing larger are words that were more frequently used.

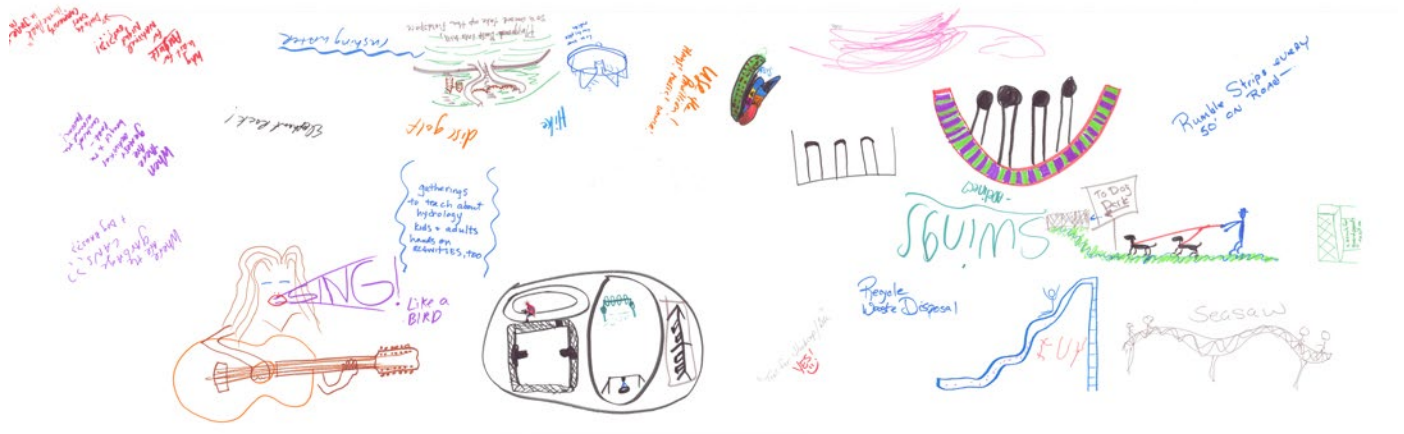
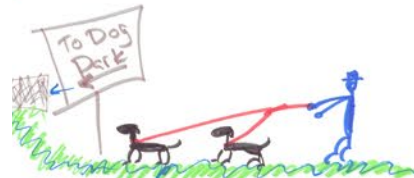
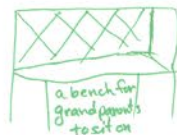

- Healthy

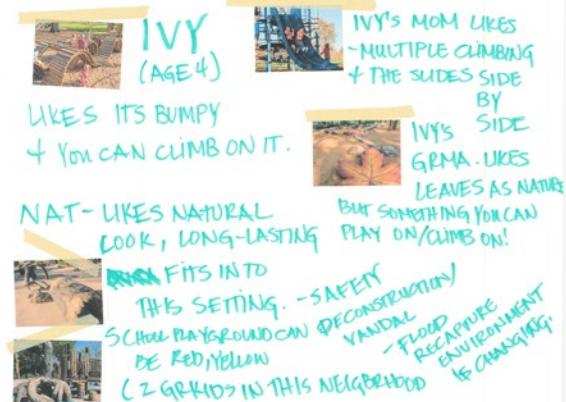

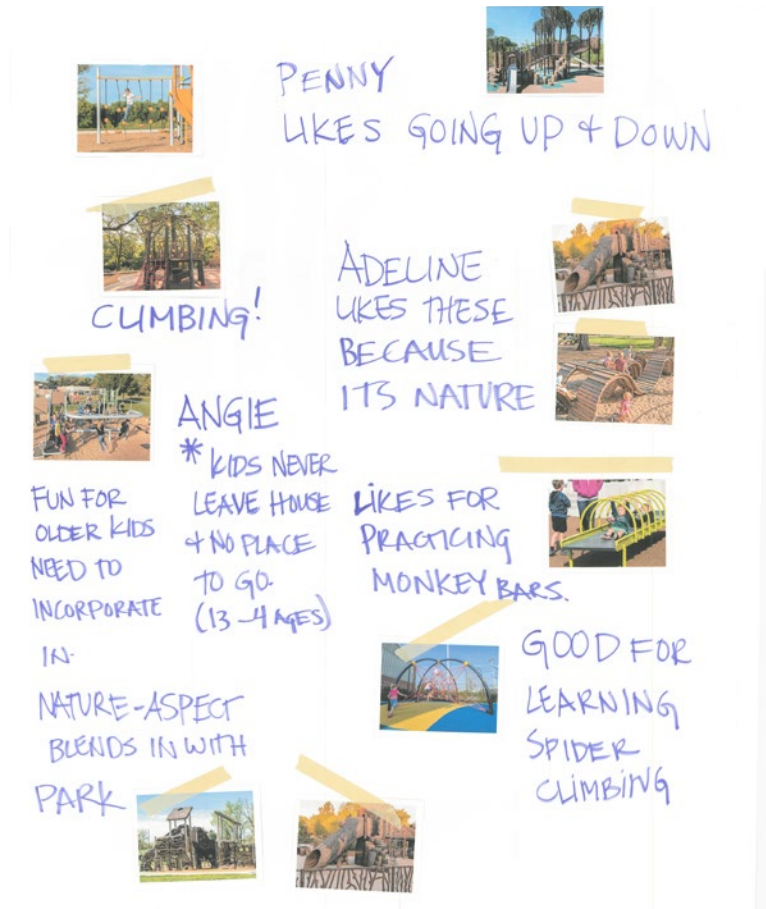
