This addendum serves to notify all bidders of the following changes to the solicitation documents:

- 1. A revised invitation to bid is attached. Deletions in the text are indicated by strikethrough, and additions are underlined. Changes are summarized here:
 - a. The City of Duluth does not need to be listed as additional insured for the insurance.
 - b. Byrd Anti-Lobbying Certification is required. The certification form to be submitted with your bid is included with this addendum.
 - c. CHUM will not be requiring payment and performance bonds.
 - d. Community Benefits Provisions will apply if the successful bid is \$150,000 or more.
 - e. Eight percent retainage for taxes does not apply to a contract with CHUM.
- 2. A revised Declaration of Non-collusion, referencing both the City of Duluth *and* CHUM is attached.

INVITATION TO BID CHUM VESTIBULE

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City of Duluth, on behalf of CHUM, seeks bids for the construction of a vestibule attached to the back entrance of the CHUM Shelter located at 102 W 2nd St, Duluth, MN. Work includes, but is not limited to excavating the site, constructing a foundation and footings for the vestibule, and building the vestibule. Please see the attached proposal package and plans for more information.

NOTE – THIS PROJECT IS FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART WITH FEDERAL COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL CONTRACT PROVISIONS.

PRE-BID/WALK-THROUGH: A prebid meeting will not be held for this project. Please submit any questions via e-mail to <u>purchasing@duluthmn.gov</u>. Responses will be provided to all interested bidders as an addendum to this solicitation.

The selected contractor will contract directly with CHUM.

Proposal forms, contract documents, plans and specifications are on file at the following offices: Duluth Builder's Exchange, Minnesota Builder's Exchange and BXWI-Fox Valley Plan Room.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

By submitting a bid, Bidders are acknowledging that they have read the City of Duluth General Bid Specifications, which are included in this bid package.

Sealed bids must be received in Purchasing before 2:00 PM local time on the bid opening date specified above. The City Purchasing Agent or her designee will conduct a public bid opening in Room 120 immediately following receipt of the bids.

No alternatives to the specification will be considered unless specifically requested.

The City of Duluth reserves the right to split the award where there is a substantial savings to the City, to waive informalities and to reject any and all bids.

The following documents must be submitted with your bid:

1. **Bid Bond** - A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of the City of Duluth, negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and acceptable surety, in an amount equal to five per cent (5%) of the total bid. Bids may be withdrawn without forfeiture of surety if the request is submitted by the Bidder and received at the Purchasing Office in writing or by e-mail prior to the scheduled bid opening.

2. **Acknowledgment of Addendum –** any changes to this solicitation will be announced via Addendum. Bidders must indicate that they have reviewed any addendum(s) by initialing and dating on the bid form where indicated. Failure to acknowledge addendum(s) may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

3. **Responsible Contractor** - No construction contract in excess of \$50,000 will be awarded unless the Bidder is a "responsible contractor" as defined in Minnesota Statute §16C.285, subdivision 3. All Bidders submitting a proposal for this project must verify that they meet the minimum criteria specified in the statute by submitting a Responsible Contractor Verification and Certification of Compliance form (attached) with their bid. The owner or officer of the company must sign the form under oath verifying compliance with each of the minimum criteria. Making a false statement under oath will render the Bidder or subcontractor that makes the false statement ineligible to be awarded a construction project and may result in termination of a contract awarded to a Bidder or subcontractors. Bidders must submit signed copies of verifications and certifications of compliance from all subcontractors at the City's request.

Please note that the following requirements also apply to this project, and any additional required documents must be submitted prior to award/contract execution. Submitting these documents with your bid will assist in expediting the process.

1. **Insurance** – Contractor must provide proof of Public Liability and Automobile Liability Insurance with limits not less than \$1,500,000 Single Limit prior to the commencement of work. The City of Duluth must be named as an additional insured. Please refer to the draft Contract, Section 7.

2. **Affidavit of Non-Collusion** – The successful bidder shall be required to execute the attached affidavit stating that he/she has not entered into a collusive agreement with any other person, firm, or corporation in regard to any bid submitted.

3. **Byrd Anti-Lobbying Certification** - Contractors must certify that that it will not and has not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant, or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. § 1352.

4. **Performance & Payment Bonds** – The awarded contractor will be required to submit performance and payments bonds in the full amount of the project cost prior to award.

5. **Project Labor Agreement (PLA)** - A PLA will be required to be executed with CHUM for any bid that is over or could virtually go over \$150,000. A copy of the City standard PLA is included in this package.

6. <u>**Community Benefits Provisions** - A Community Benefits Best Efforts Plan will be required for any project that includes a PLA. The required form is included in the bid package, as well as a link to additional community benefits information, including the program specifications and a process flowchart.</u>

7. **Out of State Contractor** - Unless a State of Minnesota Certificate of Exemption is provided, any outof-state bidder receiving a bid award will have 8% retained from invoice payments on any contracts over \$50,000. 8. **Prevailing Wage** - Not less than the minimum salaries and prevailing wages as set forth in the contract documents must be paid on this project.

Any person who fails to file the required certification shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$10,000 and not more than \$100,000 for each such failure.
