The Position

The Finance Director is a member of the City of Duluth's executive team responsible for development and implementation of departmental financial plans and programs.

The Finance Director will provide leadership that exemplifies the City's commitments to the protection of public funds, ethical decision making, excellent internal and external customer service, and continuous improvement and learning, for the department and for the city overall. The Finance Director is responsible for budget development, financial management and status reporting, general accounting, contracts, grants, procurement, customer service delivery, debt management, audits, and other functions. The Finance Department includes the Auditor's Office; Budget Office; Purchasing; and Treasury.

The ideal candidate is a dynamic, responsive leader who thrives in a fast-paced environment with a high degree of administrative independence in all areas of responsibility.

Minimum Qualifications

Required education and work experience includes a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with major course work in public or business administration, with an emphasis on finance or accounting, plus seven (7) years of increasingly responsible experience in finance, including at least three (3) years at a financial policy determination level. A master's degree in public or business administration or a related field may be substituted for one year of experience. Public sector experience preferred.
