Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (June 28, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- Storm sewer structures were installed on 1st Avenue East
- Electrical ductwork installation continued.
- The street between 5th and 6th Avenue West was opened to vehicular traffic.
- Businesses between 2nd and 3rd Avenue East were permanently connected to the water system.

What to Expect June 26 – July 2

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Pipefitters will continue to install the hot water system between 1st Avenue East and Lake Avenue.
- Permanent watermain hookups will continue between 2nd and 3rd Avenue East.
- Steam lines will be installed between 1st Avenue East and Lake Avenue.
- Electrical duct bank installation will continue.
- Asbestos containing material has been removed from the steam pipes is complete between Lake Avenue – 3rd Avenue East. Additional asbestos containing material will be removed for the remainder of the phase II area in July.

Additional Road Closure on July 8

- The road East of 3rd Avenue East through 4th Avenue East will be closed on Monday, July 8th to begin the next phase of Superior Street reconstruction. 3rd Avenue East and Superior Street will remain open until 1st Avenue East is reopened to vehicular traffic.

Weekly Meeting

- All are welcome at the weekly construction update meeting every Tuesday at 9:00 am at Greysolon on the ballroom level.

Clean and Safe Team

- The Clean and Safe Team (in bright yellow shirts) are helpful construction navigators. Look for them in the construction zone. If you need to contact a team member, call 218-390-8899.
