Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (July 12, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- -Electrical ductwork installation continued.
- -Electrical duct was installed up to 3rd Avenue East
- -The road East of 3rd Ave E through 4th Avenue East will be closed on Monday, July 8th to begin the next phase of Superior St. reconstruction. 3rd Avenue East and Superior Street will remain open until 1st Avenue East is reopened to vehicular traffic.
- -Between 3rd and 4th Avenue East light poles, signals, and bricks were removed.

What to Expect July 11-17

- -Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Pipefitters continue to install the steam and hot water lines between 1st Avenue East and Lake Avenue
- -The backfilling and grading will begin on 1st Avenue East
- -Steam lines will be installed between 1st Ave East and Lake Avenue
- -Crews will continue removing bricks from 3rd to 4th Avenue East to prepare for temporary water hookups.

Clean and Safe Team
