Superior Street Construction: Word on the Street (August 18, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- 1st Avenue East opened to north and south bound traffic. 3rd Ave E was closed to traffic and Michigan street between 1st Avenue East and 4th Avenue East was converted to two-way.
- The northern sidewalk, parking lanes and portions of the driving lanes were installed between Lake Avenue and 1st Avenue East.
- Crews dug prepared for watermain and storm drain installation at 3rd Avenue East.
- Prep work was done to install more steam and hot water lines.

What to Expect July August 15 - 21

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Crews will continue building the road to grade from 1st to 2nd Avenue East.
- Pipefitters continue to install the steam and hot water lines within the 2nd Avenue East intersection.
- Water main and storm structure work will continue at 3rd Avenue East.
- Light and signal bases are being installed throughout the project.
- Road between from 6th and 7th Avenue West will be open to vehicular traffic on Saturday, August 17.
