**Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (September 13, 2019)**

**Wrap-up of Last Week**

- Concrete pouring continued between 1st Avenue East and 2nd Avenue East.
- Crews installed storm structures within 3rd Avenue East.
- Installation work continued for the steam and hot water lines.
- A steam vault was installed in the northwest corner of 3rd Avenue East.
- A number of light and signal bases were installed.

**What to Expect July September 12-18**

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Pipefitters will make steam connections between Lake Avenue and 1st Avenue East.
- Pipefitters continue to install the steam and hot water lines from 2nd Avenue East to 3rd Avenue East.
- Crews will form and pour concrete in the 2nd Avenue East intersection.
- Water main and storm structure work will continue between 3rd Avenue East and 4th Avenue East.
- Bus stop installation will continue.
- Electrical duct, lighting and signal bases will be installed throughout the project.

- All are welcome at the weekly construction update meeting every Tuesday at 9:00 am at Greysolon on the ballroom level.

**Clean and Safe Team**

- The Clean and Safe Team (in bright yellow shirts) are helpful construction navigators. Look for them in the construction zone.
