Superior Street Construction Update: Weekly Update (October 10, 2019)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- All businesses are connected to the permanent water main.
- Installation continued for the steam and hot water lines.
- More light and signal bases were installed.
- Crews backfilled roadway and poured curb from 2nd Avenue East to 3rd Avenue East.
- Concrete was poured for sections of sidewalk and amenity zones.

What to Expect October 10 - 16

- Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.
- Crews will continue forming and pouring concrete throughout the project area.
- Pipefitters will finish the steam connection between at Lake Ave. into the Minnesota Power parking lot.
- Installation will continue for steam and hot water lines from 3rd Avenue East to 4th Avenue East.
- Water main and storm structure work will continue between 3rd Avenue East and 4th Avenue East.
- Electrical duct, lighting and signal bases will be installed throughout the project.

Weekly Meeting

- All are welcome at the weekly construction update meeting every Tuesday at 9:00 am at Greysolon on the ballroom level.

Clean and Safe Team

- The Clean and Safe Team (in bright yellow shirts) are helpful construction navigators. Look for them in the construction zone.
