Wrap-up of Last Week

-Concrete was poured for sections of sidewalk, amenity zones and driving lanes.

-More light and signal bases were installed.

-Installation continued for hot water lines.

-Pipefitters finished all steam connections.

-Curbs were poured for 3rd Avenue East.

-Signal steel was installed in 1st Avenue East. and 2nd Avenue East.

What to Expect October 30 – November 6

-Access to all businesses and residences will remain open.

-Concrete for the 3rd Avenue East intersection will be poured as well as sidewalks and amenity zones.

-Steam lines between 3rd and 4th Avenue East will be completed.

-Installation of hot water lines from 3rd Avenue East to 4th Ave E will be finished this week.

-Wiring, lighting and signal bases will be installed throughout the project.
