Superior Street Construction Update: Word on the Street (May 27, 2020)

Wrap-up of This Week

- -Carpentry crews worked on vaults throughout the project.
- -Building connections to the watermain and sewer system between Lake &1st Avenue West began.
- -Electricians began working within Lake Avenue.
- -Pipefitters began installing the steam line in Lake Avenue.
- -The 100 year-old steam heating system removals was completed between Lake Avenue to 2nd Avenue West. Crews will return to abate additional asbestos in July.
- -Crews began removing some of the sidewalk and curb in front of the Ordean Building to make an accommodation for a new ramp to the street that meets ADA guidelines.

What to Expect May 27 - June 3

- -Access to businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Pedestrian will be rerouted as several connections are being made directly into the building face.
- -Bricks and pavement will continue to be removed throughout the project zone.
- -Structural work on vaults will continue.
- -Permanent water and storm sewer tie-ins will continue.
- -Flash chambers for the hot water system will be installed at the 1st Avenue West intersection
- -Streamline and hot water installation will continue within Lake Ave.

Lake Avenue Update
