Superior Street Reconstruction Update: Word on the Street (June 10, 2020)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- -Building connections to the watermain and sewer system continued from Lake to 1st Avenue West.
- -Carpentry crews worked on vaults throughout the project.
- -Electricians continued working within Lake Avenue.
- -Pipefitters continued installing the steam and hot water lines in Lake Avenue.
- -1st Avenue West was built to grade, and a portion of roadway concrete was poured.
- -Businesses between 1st Avenue West and 2nd Avenue West were connected to temporary water.

What to Expect June 10 – 17

- -Access to businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Pedestrian will be rerouted as several utility connections are being made directly into buildings.
- -Bricks, pavement and ledge rock will continue to be removed throughout the project zone.
- -Structural work on vaults will continue.
- -Permanent water and storm sewer tie-ins will continue.
- -Steam and hot water installation will continue within Lake Avenue.
- -Water will be shut down on Thursday, June 11 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm between 2nd Avenue West and 3rd Avenue West for all buildings fed off the Superior Street watermain to address two critical paths for the project going forward.
- -Storm structures will begin to be placed within 1st Avenue West.
