### Superior Street Reconstruction Update: Word on the Street (July 29, 2020)

### Wrap-up of Last Week

- -Crews removed bricks, paving and ledge rock throughout the project zone.
- -Carpentry crews worked on the east plaza at Lake Ave and a bus shelter between Lake and 1st Avenue West.
- -Crews continued grading, forming and pouring roadway at Lake Avenue.
- -Pipefitters continued installing the hot water lines in 1st Avenue West.
- -Crews finished connecting old storm sewer system to the new storm sewer system in 1st Avenue West.
- -Connections to permanent water and sanitary connections were completed between Lake Avenue and 2nd Avenue West.

### What to Expect July 29 - August 5

- -Access to businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Bricks, pavement and ledge rock will continue to be removed throughout the project zone.
- -Crews will pour roadway at Lake Avenue.
- -Structural work on vaults and the east plaza at Lake Avenue will continue.
- -Storm storm sewer tie-ins will continue from 1st Avenue West to 2nd Avenue West.
- -Hot water installation will continue in 1st Avenue West.
- -Electrical work will continue in the 1st Avenue West intersection.

### Lake Avenue Update
