Superior Street Reconstruction Update: Word on the Street (September 2, 2020)

Wrap-up of Last Week

- -Crews removed bricks, paving and ledge rock throughout the project zone.
- -Waterproofing began on the Lake Avenue East Plaza.
- -Electrical crews installed a signal base at 1st Avenue W.
- -Pipefitters finished installing the hot water lines between 1st and 2nd Avenue West.
- -Carpentry crews worked on vaults and light bases throughout the project zone.
- -The existing watermain between 2nd and 3rd Avenue West was removed.
- -Fusing began on the final portion of the water main located between 2nd and 3rd Avenue West.

What to Expect September 2 - 9

- -Access to businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Bricks, pavement and ledge rock will continue to be removed throughout the project zone.
- -Structural work on vaults and the east plaza at Lake Avenue will continue.
- -Electrical duct will be installed at 1st Avenue West.
- -Hot water installation will continue from 1st to 2nd Avenue West.
- -Fusing will continue for the watermain between 2nd and 3rd Avenue West.
- -Crews will be off Saturday through Monday to honor the Labor Day Weekend.
