# Wrap-up of Last Week

- -Crews removed bricks, paving and ledge rock at 3rd Avenue West
- -Concrete was poured between Lake Ave and 1st Avenue West.
- -Curb was poured between 1st and 2nd Avenue West.
- -Electrical crews installed light poles and pulled wiring.
- -Pipefitters worked on hot water lines from 2nd to 3rd Avenue West.
- -Carpentry crews worked on a steam vault and light bases.
- -Storm sewer was completed in 2nd Avenue West.
- -The Lake Ave and Superior Street intersection was opened heading East.

#### What to Expect September 30 - October 7

- -Access to businesses and residences will remain open.
- -Structural work on signal bases and planters will continue.
- -Electrical duct will be installed at 2st Avenue West.
- -Hot water installation will continue from 2nd to 3rd Avenue West.
- -Bricks, pavement and ledge rock will continue to be removed in 3rd Avenue West.
- -Crews will dig to make the watermain connection across 3rd Avenue West.
- -Concrete will be poured throughout the project zone.
