AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 27.3.C OF THE DULUTH CITY CODE REGARDING SCREENING OF COMMERCIAL CONTAINERS.

## CITY PROPOSAL:

The city of Duluth does ordain:

Section 1: That Chapter 50, Article IV, Section 27.3.C of the Duluth City Code is hereby amended as follows:

1. Not adjacent to structure wall.

Commercial containers that are not located adjacent to a wall of an existing principal or accessory structure shall be screened from view as follows:

- (a) On three sides with a <u>an opaque</u> wall constructed of <del>masonry, brick, wood, stone, or similar</del> <u>durable, weather resistant</u> material and at least as tall as the container being screened;
- (b) On the fourth side a gate constructed of wood or metal an opaque, durable material and at least as tall as the container being screened;
  - 2. Adjacent to structure wall.

Commercial containers that are located adjacent to a wall of an existing principal or accessory structure shall be screened from view as follows:

- (a) On two sides with a wall that is (1) constructed of <u>an opaque</u> the same principal materials and colors used on the wall of the principal or accessory building that forms the third wall of the enclosure <u>durable</u> weather resistant material, or dense vegetation and (2) at least as tall as the container being screened; and (3) in compliance with applicable fire and building codes;
- (b) On the fourth side a gate constructed of <u>an opaque wood or metal durable material</u> and at least as tall as the container being screened.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days from and after its passage and publication.

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

This ordinance implements a UDC text amendment related to Duluth City Code Chapter 50, Article IV, Section

File #: 25-018-O, Version: 1

27.3.C regarding screening standards for exterior commercial containers to add flexibility to screening material requirements and ease the burden of development.

The planning commission held a public hearing and considered the changes at a Tuesday, June 10, 2025, planning commission meeting, as documented in Attachment 2. The commission voted 6 yeas, 0 nays, and 0 abstentions, to recommend that the city council approve the proposed text change.
