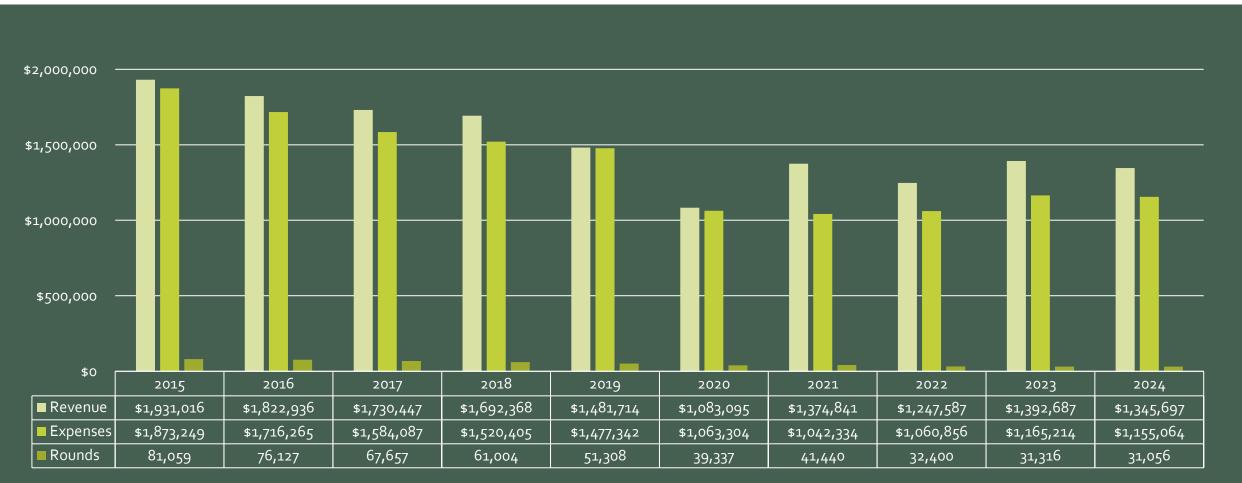

#### REVENUEVS. EXPENSES

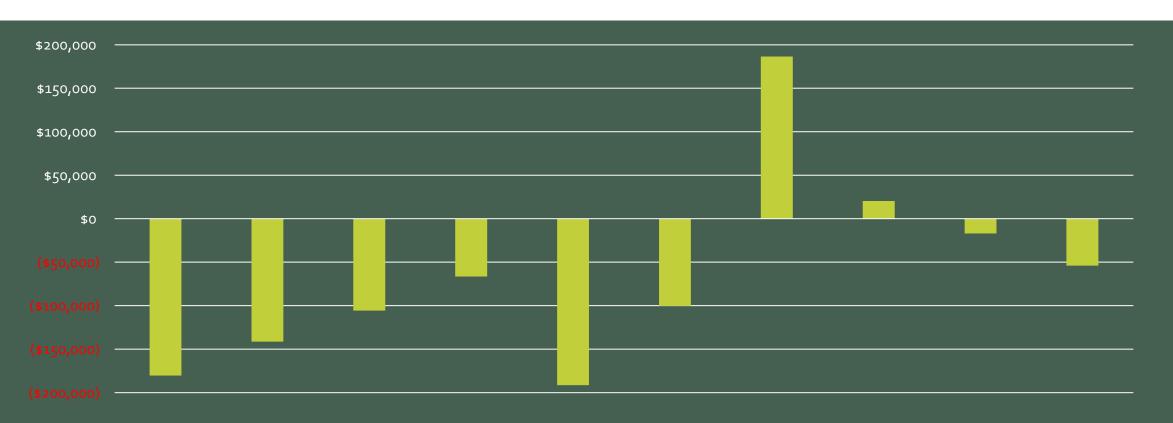

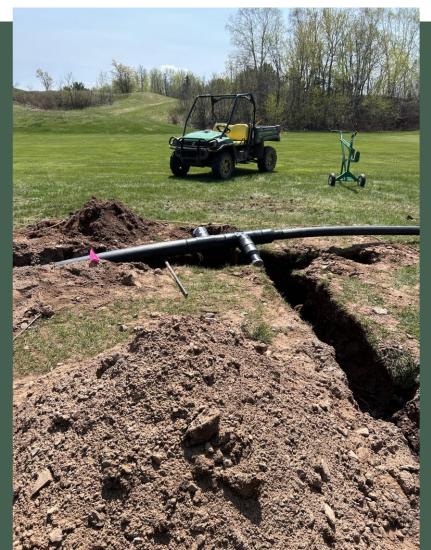

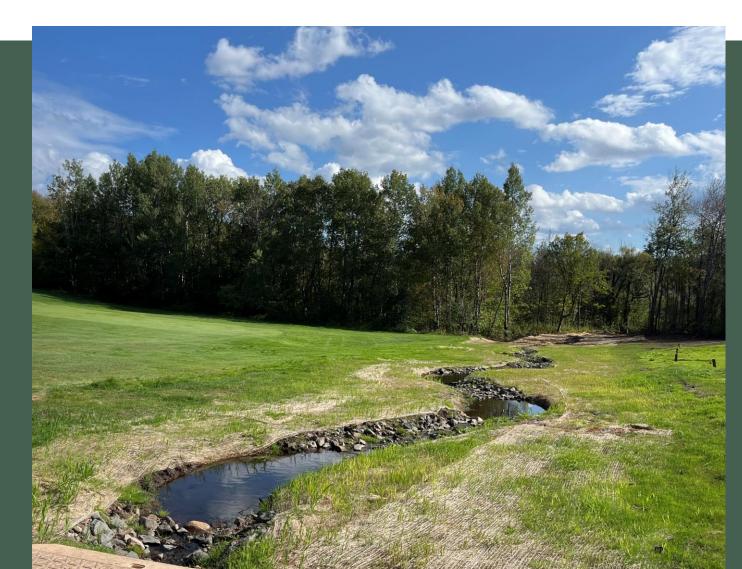




### **BUCKINGHAM CREEK RESTORATION**

#### • \$910,000

- Daylight the creek
- Move creek "offline" from irrigation ponds
- Funding sourced from grants from Conservation Partners Legacy Program and the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative
- Project administered by Soil and Water Conservation District and MN DNR





#### LOOKING AHEAD

- Rebranding the course
  - Signage, marketing, merchandise, online presence, etc.
- Programming collaboration with Parks & Recreation
- Design for replacement clubhouse
- Disc golf course not returning
  - Baskets will be retained for eventual new course elsewhere
