On Wednesday, March 19th, 2014 at 3:56 PM Duluth Police responded to a burglary that jus at a residence in the 300 block of West 5th Street.

Initial investigation revealed a 28 year old female resident was home when she heard someone into her house and run up her stairs. The suspect ran out of the house when he heard her. Resofficers found the door frame was broken to gain entry to the house. The suspect was describblack male in his 30's wearing a bright red fleece top. Officers located him a 4:01 PM at Mess Avenue & 7 th Street and he was taken into custody. The suspect was identified as James Lee 30 year old male resident of Duluth.

James Lee Berry has the following convictions in Minnesota:

2003 - 5th Degree Sale of Controlled Substance & Disorderly Conduct

2006 - Disorderly Conduct

2007 – Terroristic Threats (Felony), Possession of Firearm by a Felon (Felony) Violation of O Protection, Terroristic Threats (Felony) & Disorderly Conduct

2009 – Manufacture/Sell/Transfer Non-Controlled Substance as a Narcotic (Felony)

2010 - Trespassing & Disorderly Conduct

2011 – Forgery (Felony), Wrongfully Obtained Assistance (Felony), Possession of Stolen Prop Fleeing a Police Officer & Disorderly Conduct

2012 – 2nd Degree Burglary (Felony), Receiving Stolen Property 2 counts (Felonies)
