**On Thursday April 24<sup>th</sup>, P.A.V.S.A. will host the annual Take Back the Night event in the Minnesota Power Plaza on Superior Street and Lake Avenue. The event starts at 5pm.**

**At 7pm, participants will line up for the Take Back the Night March through downtown Duluth. The march will proceed East on Superior Street past Lake Avenue toward 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue East where they turn up to 1<sup>st</sup> Street. They turn left on 1<sup>st</sup> Street and march in the LOWER lane to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West. 1<sup>st</sup> Street remains open with traffic using the UPPER westbound lane. They then turn down 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave West in the LEFT lane and proceed to Superior Street to turn left back to Minnesota Power Plaza.**

**The procession will be lead and followed by marked squad cars, and other squads will assist in closing intersections as the group passes.**

**Drivers are urged to use caution when in the affected areas of the march, to expect traffic delays along the route, and to watch for officers directing traffic.**
