

On Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 5:19 am Duluth Police were called to a residence in the 1300 block of East 7<sup>th</sup> Street for a burglary that had just occurred. The suspect was reported to have left with the victim's computer.

Officers located the suspect a few blocks away with the stolen computer and they found he had a replica handgun tucked in his waistband. He was identified as Isaiah Charles Buckanaga, a 24 year old resident of Duluth.
