Studies have found that the public has many misconceptions about smoke alarms, which may put them at increased risk in the event of a home fire. For example, only a small percentage of people know how old their smoke alarms are, or how often they need to be replaced.

- •Smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years.
- •Make sure you know how old all the smoke alarms are in your home.
- •To find out how old a smoke alarm is, look at the date of manufacture on the back of the alarm; the alarm should be replaced 10 years from that date.
