## Duluth Invaders seeks help tackling invasive plants

Residents invited to learn about common invasive plants at volunteer work events

[Duluth, MN] - Duluth Invaders, a service initiative coordinated by Duluth Parks and Recreation, is hosting a series of informational volunteer work events during the 2016 summer season to educate and inform residents of common unwanted, non-native invasive species. Duluth Invaders staff will be on-hand and the events will cover identification, removal and disposal of five prevalent invasive plants: Garlic Mustard, Japanese Knotweed (informally known as "bamboo"), Tansy, Buckthorn, and Honeysuckle.

Meet at lower parking area near the playground on Lincoln Park Drive just up from 3rd Street
