[Duluth, MN] - The City of Duluth is announcing the recent awards totaling \$55,500 in grants from the Parks Fund Neighborhood Grant program to community organizations. The Fund is administered by the Duluth Superior Area Community Foundation. The fund helps support community groups that enhance both the physical and social aspects of City parks.
