

The City of Duluth is preparing to submit its FY24 Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing) grant application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The grant is designed to help cities overcome barriers to affordable housing production and preservation.

Public Comment Period: From Monday September 30, 2024, to Monday October 14, 2024, Duluth residents can review and comment on the draft application via the City of Duluth's website.

Public Hearing: A public hearing will be held Wednesday, October 9, 2024, at 5:30 pm at Duluth City Hall. Community members are invited to provide input on the proposal before its submission to HUD.

About the Grant: The PRO Housing program helps communities expand affordable housing by addressing barriers caused by outdated zoning, land use policies, or regulations; inefficient procedures; gaps in available resources for development; deteriorating or inadequate infrastructure; lack of neighborhood amenities; or challenges to preserving existing housing stock such as increasing threats from natural hazards, redevelopment pressures, or expiration of affordability requirements.
